The **Hazelwood Community Association** began in 1989 as an informal group of neighbors concerned about local issues. HCA members worked with King County to get the boardwalk and steps in Hazelwood Park. They helped to found modern Newcastle in 1994, and Newcastle Trails, and the Newcastle Historical Society. The HCA lobbied to create Donegal Park, built the Porter BBQ, and worked for sidewalks, speed bumps, and improvements to our parks and trails. Volunteers are still needed.

Hazelwood is one of Newcastle's oldest and largest neighborhoods (nearly 500 homes). The earliest Hazelwood subdivisions (including Donegal and Newport Woods) were built in the 1960's, when downtown Newcastle was pastureland, and Olympus was parkland. Hazelwood Ridge is the newest subdivision.
